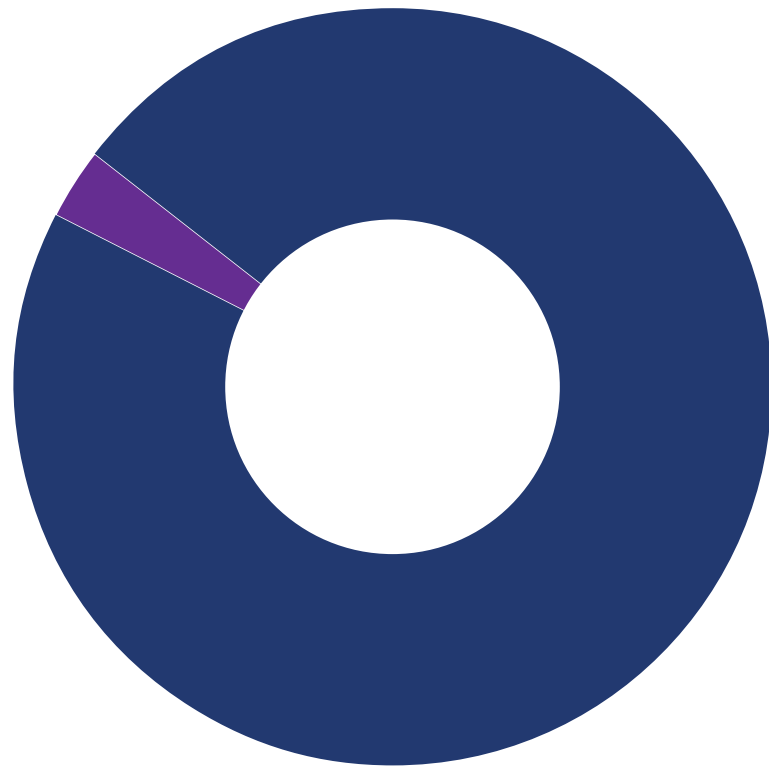

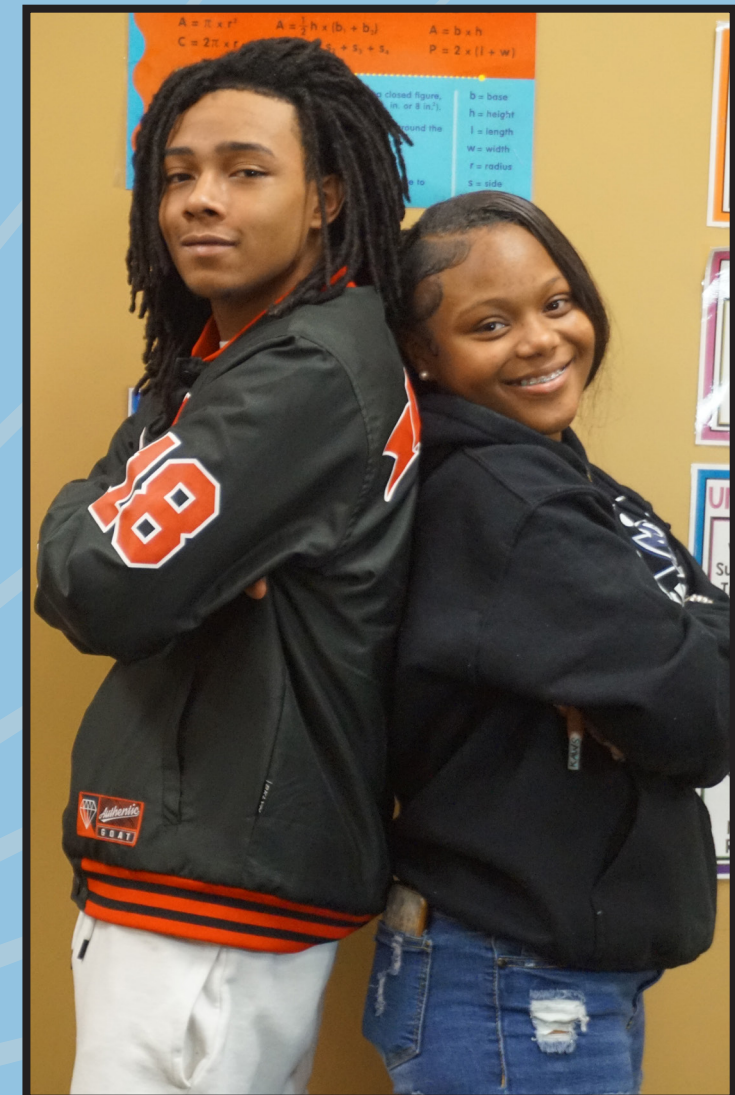
The Dayton School fosters a family environment by hosting yearly events regularly attended by students, parents and stakeholders.
